This group of musicians will perform pop and rock music. Enjoy the show, refreshments will be served. All ages

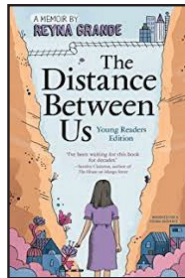
