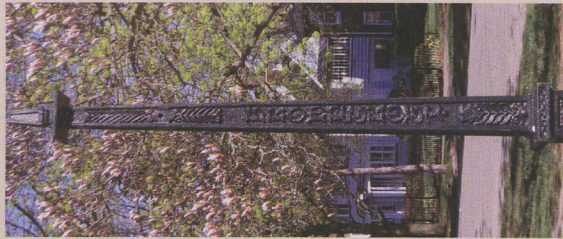

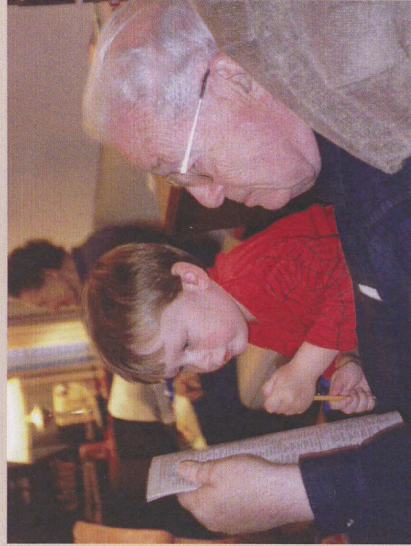
# Browncroft Neighborhood Association

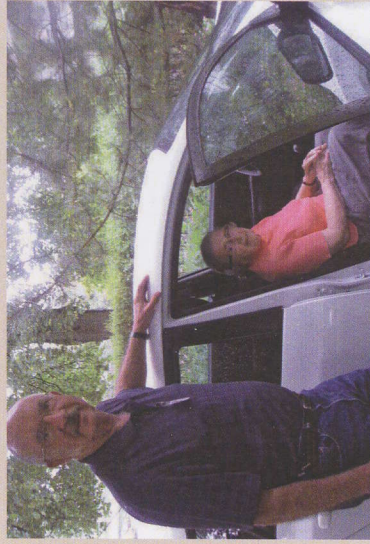
## Home Maintenance Service Providers

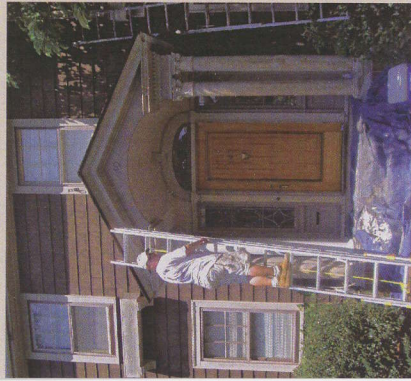


## Transportation

BNA's partnership with LifeSpan has resulted in *On Your Way with BNA*. This is a group of volunteer drivers from the Browncroft neighborhood who are available to take residents where they need to go (eg: medical appointments and necessary errands). In addition to thorough training, all drivers have received background checks. Rides are free and can be arranged a week in advance by calling 733-4386.

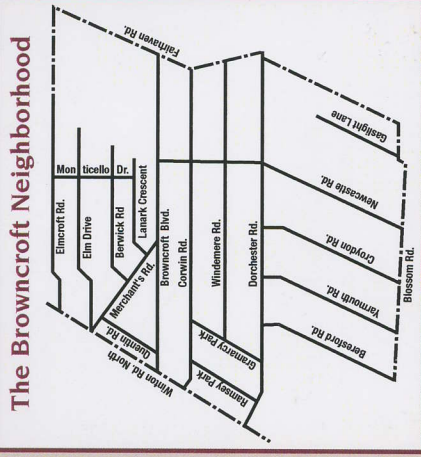

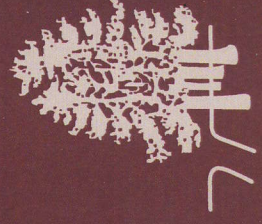
